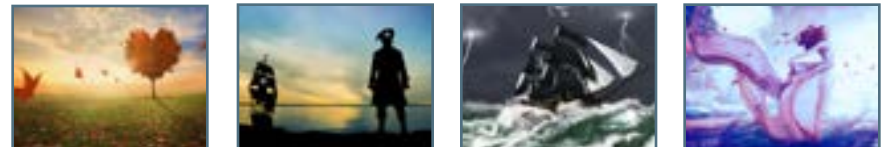
The Boy Who Was Loved by the Wind is an award-winning story published in the 2018 *Bravura Literary Journal*.
